1. Budget Review

9-months actuals and budgets of 2021/22 were reviewed and allocations for 2022/23 were agreed. Labelling and consolidation of line items was agreed, which included splitting out planning professional fees from general legal and staffing advice.

2. Recommendations

- a) Recommendation to Full Council on 12th January 2022:
 To request a Precept for the financial year 2022/23 of £160,495
 It is noted that the recommended precept would be an increase of 3.55% and an increase of £2.78 per household on Council Tax Band D
- b) Recommendations for allocations of unspent at year-end, for ratification at the February Full Council meeting:
 - Income of £7,000 from UDC in April 2021 should be appropriately ringfenced
 - Staffing underspend should be split between Locum Clerk and Planning Professional Advice, which will give a ringfenced Planning allocation of approximately £20,000.
 - Training underspend should be ringfenced for training
 - Washroom services underspend should be ringfenced for possible increase in frequency
 - Underspends on grounds maintenance allocations should be amalgamated and ringfenced for grounds maintenance
